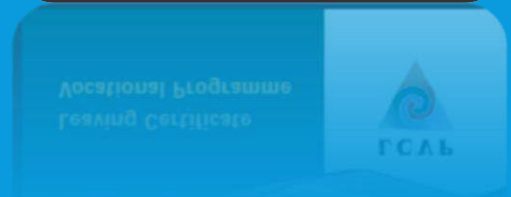
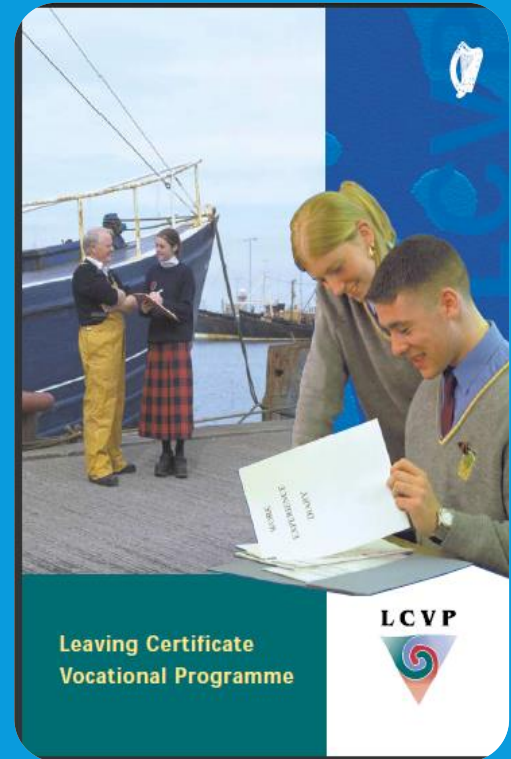




LCVP LEAVING CERTIFICATE VOCATIONAL PROGRAMME



LCVP

- What is LCVP?

This programme is in existence since the 1980s and has been revised in 1994 and again in 2002.

- It was in response to the challenge placed on Ireland's education system by a changing work and business environment.

- Programme V Subject

- Department recognised as Programme with specific requirements attached to it.

- Its an additional 8th Subject in the School

PROGRAMME REQUIREMENTS

- 2-year duration
- Minimum 5 Leaving Certificate Subjects at Higher, Ordinary or Foundation level
 - to include Irish
 - to include 2 Subjects from the Vocational Subject Groupings list
- Modern European Language
- ICT

VOCATIONAL SUBJECT GROUPINGS

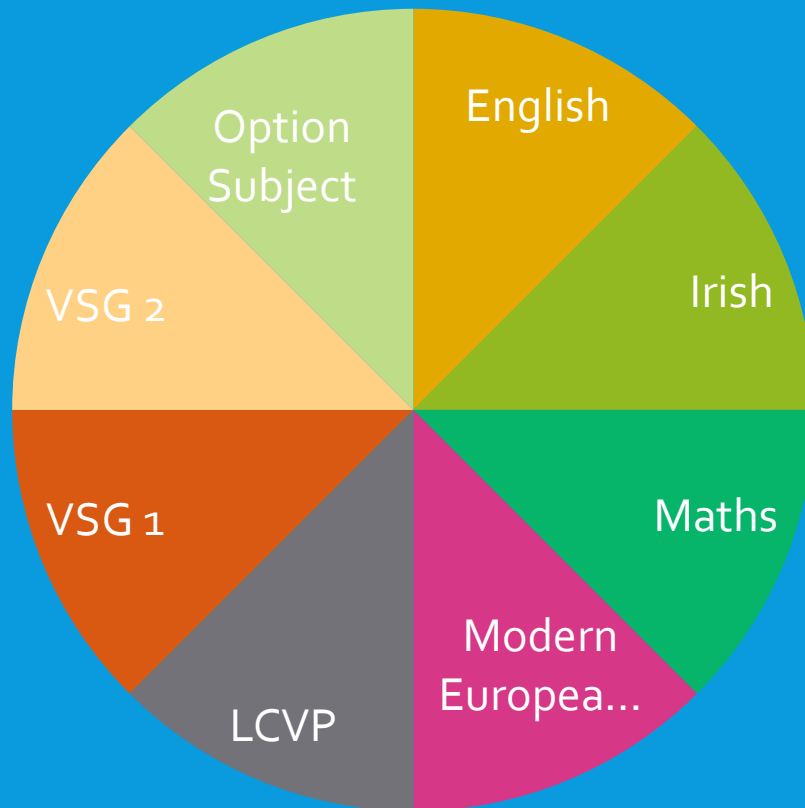
Students must have one of the following combinations in order to do LCVP

- Art and Accounting or Business or Economics
- Biology and Chemistry or Physics
- Biology, Home Economics, Agricultural Science- **Any two**
- Construction Studies and Accounting or Business or Economics
- Home Economics and Accounting or Business or Economics
- Home Economics and Art
- Music and Accounting or Business or Economics

- Agricultural Science and Constructions Studies
- Agricultural Science and Chemistry or Physics

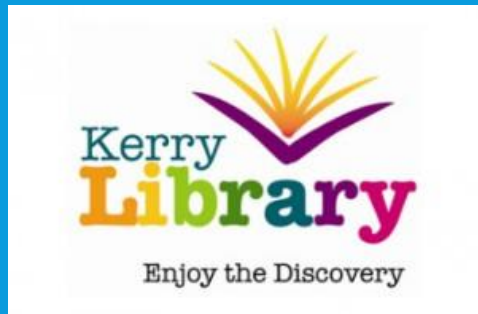

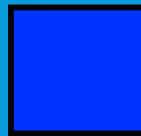
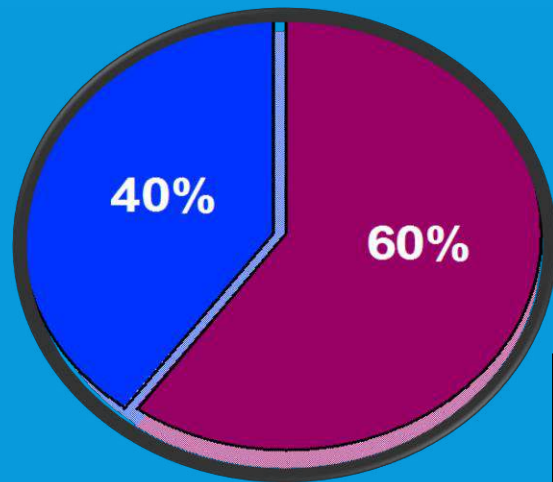
6TH YEAR

A COLLECTION OF DOCUMENTS

Core Items

- Curriculum Vitae
- Career Investigation
- Summary Report
- Enterprise/Action Plan

OPTIONAL ITEMS:

Two out of Four

- Diary of Work Experience
- Enterprise Report
- Report on 'My Own Place'
- Recorded Interview/Presentation

WRITTEN EXAMINATION

- **Section A - Audio-Visual Presentation**
 - Video sequence of an enterprise
- **Section B - Case Study**
 - Received 4 weeks in advance
- **Section C - General Questions**
 - Choice of 4 questions from 6

LCVP RECOGNITION

- Entry to Universities and Institutes of Technology
- Link Modules is a qualifying subject for points however, the students must have 6 core subjects plus LCVP to use it for points for university.
